#### **EVENT DETAILS**

On 27 July 2024, the Head Post Office of Bilaspur (C.G.) organized an informative session at the Centre of Excellence (COE) Lab, Atal Bihari Vajpayee Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.), specifically aimed at students from the Department of Computer Science and Applications. - **Government Services Integration**: The program's role in streamlining and integrating government services through India Post.
- **Customer Enrollment**: Strategies to broaden the reach of government schemes by leveraging India Post's extensive network.
- Local Government Involvement: The importance of incorporating local government officials in the program to enhance execution and impact.
- **Branding and Communication**: The establishment of a cohesive branding strategy and communication plan to improve service delivery and public engagement.
- Advanced Planning: Emphasis on meticulous planning, data sharing, and stakeholder participation to achieve the broader goals of community development.

In addition to discussing the DCDP, Mr. Sahu and Mrs. Dwivedi provided detailed insights into various services offered by India Post, including:

- **Payments Bank Services**: Information on India Post's banking services, including savings accounts, fixed deposits, and other financial products.
- Financial Services: Details on various financial services like money transfers and insurance products.
- **Citizen-Centric Services**: Overview of services designed to meet the needs of citizens, such as postal services, pension payments, and government scheme benefits.
- E-commerce Solutions: Parcel and logistics solutions for e-commerce businesses, including cash on delivery (COD) and reverse logistics.
- **Philately**: Services related to the collection and sale of postage stamps, promoting philately as a hobby and a cultural pursuit.
- **Business Solutions**: Customized mailing solutions for businesses including bulk mailing, address verification, and logistics support.
- **Digital Services**: Facilities for bill payments, recharges, and online services through India Post's digital platforms.


